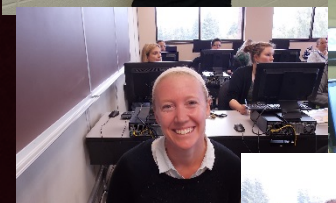

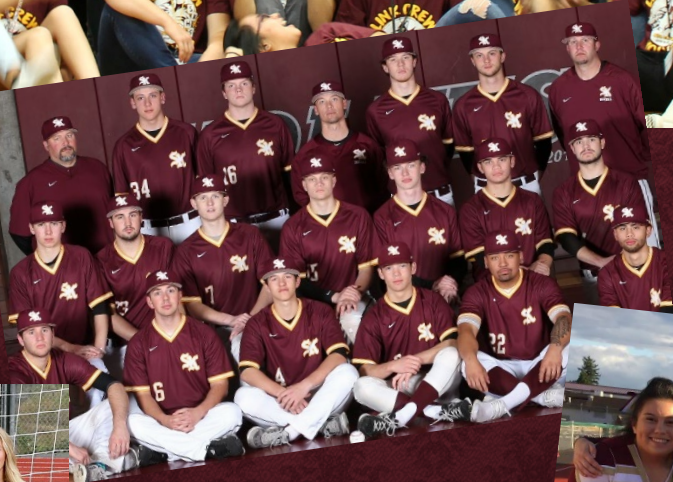

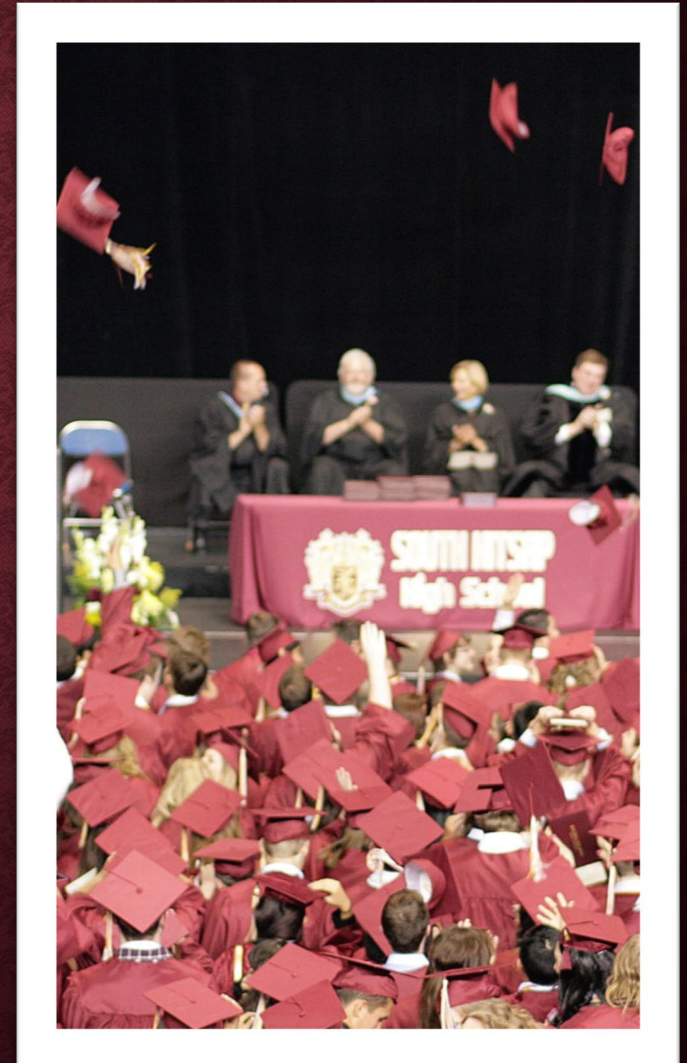

- Helps students **explore careers and college** options

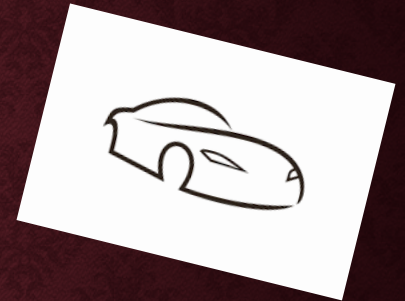

CTE COURSES



- **Explore options for your future**

Video production, Engineering/CAD, Automotive, Early Childhood Education, Sports Medicine, Computer Sciences, Business and Marketing, Culinary, Vet Sciences, Agriculture, Graphic Design

- **CTE Dual Credit**

Courses aligned with community college course. If you earn an A or B student can apply for the community college credit.



Getting College & Career Ready

Advanced Placement (AP) – 26 AP courses at SK!

- College credit possible depending on AP exam scores

AP Capstone

- Students take AP Seminar in grade 11, followed by AP Research in grade 12. Students who earn scores of 3 or higher in AP Seminar and AP Research and on **four additional AP Exams (9-12th grade)** of their choosing receive the AP Capstone Diploma™.



Getting College & Career Ready

University of Washington in the High School classes

- UW Astronomy (available 10-12th grades) UW tuition \$370 per semester
- UW Spanish (available 10-12th grades) UW tuition \$370 (optional)

Junior/Senior Year option:

West Sound Technical Skills Center



- 12 programs that teach skills specific to a technical program.

Running Start

- Must qualify with the Accuplacer test or state exams
- Earn up to 15 credits per quarter – tuition free

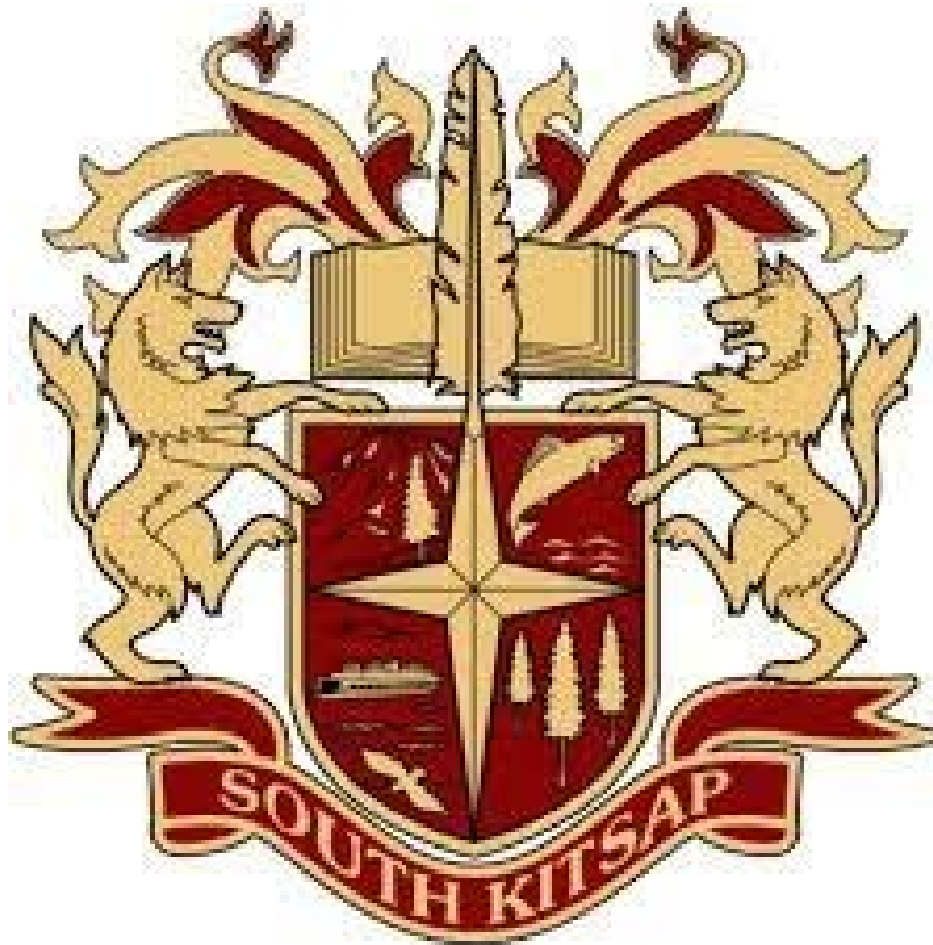
Link Crew – (tentative dates, more info. will come later)
