REMINDERS!

TICKETS

Tickets for both Prom and Graduation **will be withheld** from students who have outstanding fines or class fees due.

Prom—Tickets are purchased by **graduating seniors only** from the ASB office. Attendees are permitted to bring **one** guest. Guest criteria and permission forms must be approved by school administrators by 3 p.m. the Wednesday prior to Prom.

Graduation— Graduating seniors receive **10 free tickets for the Tacoma Dome** for family or friends. Subject to availability, additional tickets may be purchased for \$2 each.

Tickets will be available for pick up **by graduates only from the ASB office June 6-10**. Students must show their I.D. We cannot release tickets to family or friends.

Return all novels, textbooks, Chromebooks, uniforms or any other school materials by the end of the day on June 9, 2022

GRADUATION STATUS

If you receive an Academic Concern report/letter it means your graduation status is in question. Follow these steps:

1. Pick up a pink graduation clearance from your counselor beginning June 1
2. Your pink form must be signed by both your teachers and counselor once they are certain you will **pass all your classes, WA state history and Xello** (High School & Beyond Plan) requirement.
3. Bring pink card to ASB office to collect graduation tickets.

GRADUATION REHEARSAL

Graduation rehearsal is MANDATORY on Friday, June 10. Students gather in the main gym at 7:30 a.m. If you do not attend rehearsal you are not permitted to walk with your class on Saturday, June 11.

Following rehearsal graduates are bussed to the middle schools to participate in the **“Walk of the Graduates”**. This is an opportunity to be congratulated by previous teachers and staff and to exemplify the pride of accomplishment to incoming classes.

Students should bring their cap and gown to rehearsal. The Walk of the Graduates is optional. Students are returned to the high school by approximately 10:30 a.m. and are expected to **leave campus**.
